Playing Field, Trysull

Cllr Beard offered to fit a new gate post to gate on playing field car park. Mr. Harper to be notified. Picnic bench - e-mail received stating PFA do not wish to have a picnic bench in the position it is in now. Clerk to ask Mr. Mike Harvey to discuss the position of a new bench with the person donating the bench.

Playing Field, Seisdon

Clerk to reply to e-mail from Mr. Patrick, Trysull Tigers, stating the Parish Council have no plans to give up this facility.

Fencing the field was discussed and no decision reached. This matter to be discussed further.

New litter bin obtained and needs to be installed.

1350 Footpaths

Footpath 25 very overgrown and impassable. To be reported to the County Council.

1477 Village Hall

Additional domestic bin obtained to help with the litter problem at the Village Hall and playing field.

1795 Police

PCSO Alexander Rathbone visited the meeting and stated there was nothing to report.

2724 SID signs/Community Speed Watch

CSW signs ordered. Posts to be erected by Cllr. Beardsmore.

2753 Village Entrance signs

Cllr. Kelly to give presentation and meeting arranged for Tuesday 16th November at 7.00 p.m at the Village Hall. When gates are purchased C.Cllr. Mrs. Wilson stated she would arrange for the erection of these in their approved sites.

2821 Councillor responsibilities

Cllr. Kelly has compiled a draft list of parish councillor responsibilities.

2822 Footpath 1 - barbed wire

Street scene may be able to assist with removal of barbed wire.

2829 Cracked stone wall - footpath 11

Stone wall cracked and leaning over the path. Cllr. Smith to inspect.

2830 Defibrillator

Defibrillator to be wired and fitted onto the Village Hall wall. Photo shoot to be arranged.

2842 Fox Road signage

C.Cllr. Wilson reported work will be undertaken on 29th and 30th November when Fox Road is being closed to carry out work by B.T.

2844 Informal meeting with organisations

Chairman will get in touch with local organisations with a view to meet and discuss parish matters.

2845 Hedges covering road signs

To be investigated.

2847 Street Scene

Hawthorn hedge to be planted on verge in front of school.

Improvements to field on corner of Feiashill Road (Charity land)

Removal of mound of soil on corner of Seisdon Road/Ebstree Road.

2848 Telephone kiosk to library

The Chairman felt the kiosk could look aesthetically better without the wood across the windows. Moving the shelves should not affect the functionality and allow access to glass for cleaning and maintenance.

2850 Bridges in Seisdon and Trysull

Bridge wall in Post Office Road has been rebuilt but Cllr. Beard stated there are only two reflective posts at the end and it needed a fence erected to prevent anyone falling down the bank. The Clerk was asked to e-mail C.Cllr. Mrs Wilson with a copy to Diane Firkin. Trysull Holloway bridge has not yet been repaired.

2851 Tree saplings, Seisdon Road, Trysull

Cllr. Beard offered to treat the tree saplings and Cllr. Smith stated he would approach the tenant of the land before treatment begins.

2852 Queens Jubilee

It is planned to plant trees. Celebrations were discussed in the order of an Art and Craft Show which would be a joint undertaking by the PC, the PCC and the WI with any show proceeds from donated catering etc going to the Church. Cllr. Beard suggested incorporating a show of vintage cars/tractors. The Chairman suggested that a committee be formed to formulate organisation, budgets and feasibility of this considerable diversification.

Arts & Craft Show

Cllr. Mrs. Johns reported that date for this show is 11th June 2022 and is liaising with the Church and the School. The Village Hall has been booked.
